
Nobel Peace Prize nominee in Perth Tuesday Nov 22 to launch new book

St John of God Hospital Subiaco will host Nobel Peace Prize nominee and international human rights lawyer David Matas next Tuesday for the launch of his book "Bloody Harvest – The killing of Falun Gong for their organs".

Mr Matas has brought the practice of exploiting prisoners of conscience as a source of organs into the spotlight. He was nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize in 2010 for his work relating to the investigation of organ harvesting crimes against Falun Gong practitioners in China.
